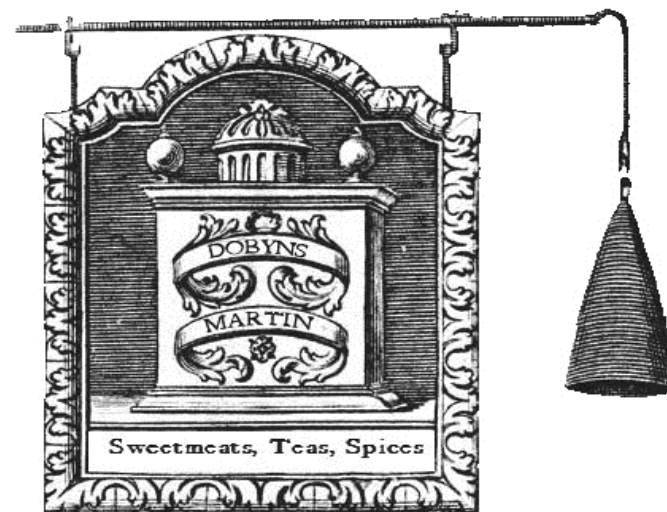

There is no evidence to support it. Brick tea was made from the sweepings of the tea sorting floor, mixed with ox blood or manure, compacted into bricks for easy transport on the *China* Road into Siberia. Once there it was generally mixed with rancid yak butter for a dish, not a beverage. Yum!
